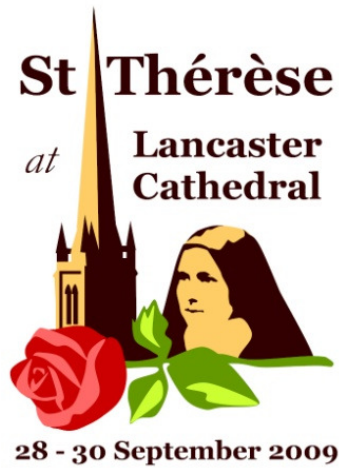

All the public Liturgies will be proper to St Thérèse. Most of the Masses will be celebrated by the Bishop, and members of the Cathedral Chapter will be present for the arrival and departure liturgies.

- Opportunities to light candles close to the reliquary
- There will be a box for petitions close to the reliquary
- The shop will be open, with extra products relating to St Thérèse
